



# March Block

1. Gather and cut the following:

Color 1: (2) 3 1/2" squares (for HST)

Color 2: (4) 3 1/2" squares (for HST)

Color 3: (4) 3 1/2" squares (for HST)

Background: (4) 2 1/2" squares

(10) 3 1/2" squares (for HST)

(4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Center – Can be a fussy cut focus fabric or background fabric

(1) 4 1/2" square

2. Sew HSTs:

You will need to make 2 1/2" unfinished HST in the following combinations

(4) Color 1 (C1) & Background (BK)

(8) Color 2 (C2) & Background (BK)

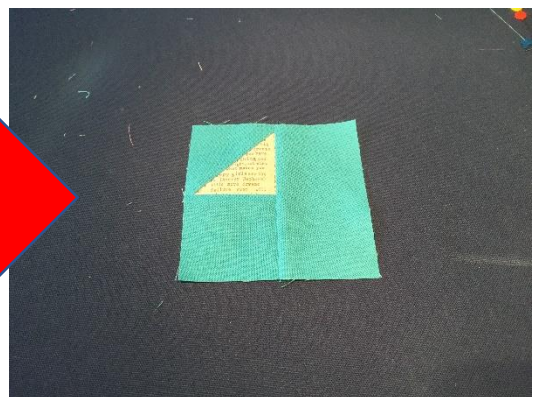
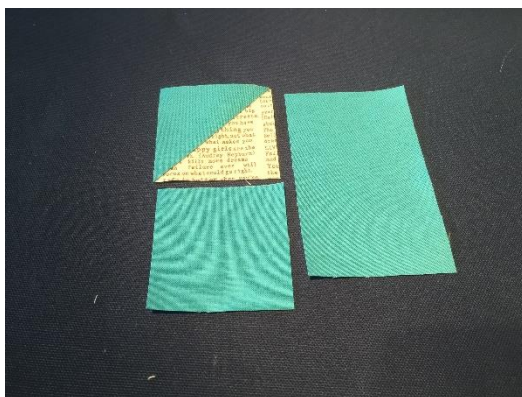
(8) Color 3 (C3) & Background (BK)

3. Arrange C1&BK HST, a 3 1/2" BK square, and a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" BK rectangle as shown.

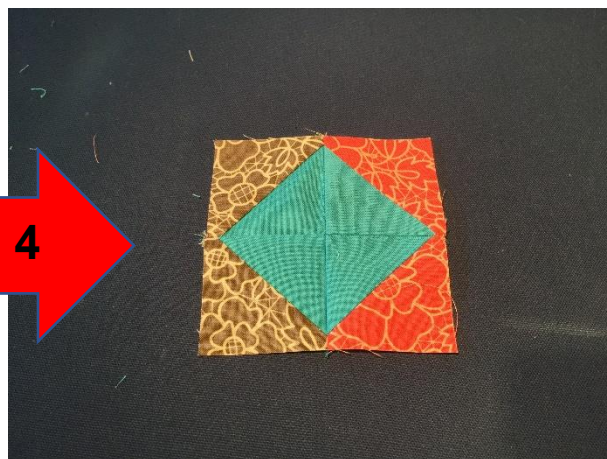
Sew the HST to the square. Press toward the square.

Sew this to the rectangle. Press toward the rectangle.

Repeat for a total of 4 units.



4. Arrange (2) C2&BK and (2) C3&BK HSTs as shown.  
Sew together, press toward darker fabric if possible  
Repeat for a total of 4 units.



5. Using your center/focus piece, the units from Step 3, and the units from Step 4, arrange as shown

6. Pin, sew, and press.

Suggestion: On the outer column, press towards the corner pieces. In the middle, column. Press towards the center/focus piece.

7. Press and trim to 12.5 square.
