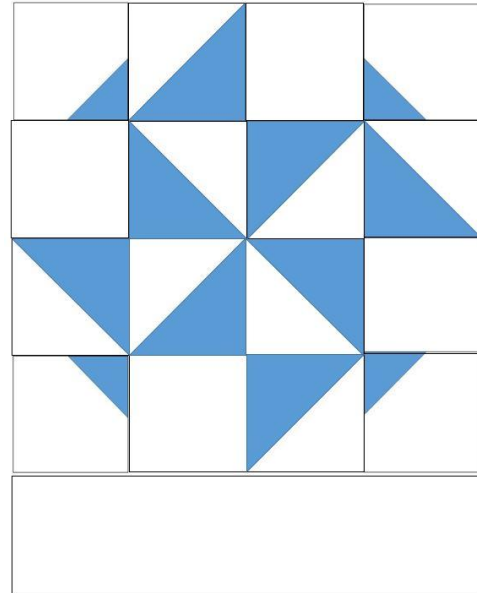


Instruction Set 10 - TWIN

Step 1: Assembling The Snowballs Row, Part 1

Using a Snowball from Set 8: Step 4 and a Background $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle you cut in Set 8: Step 5, arrange as shown.

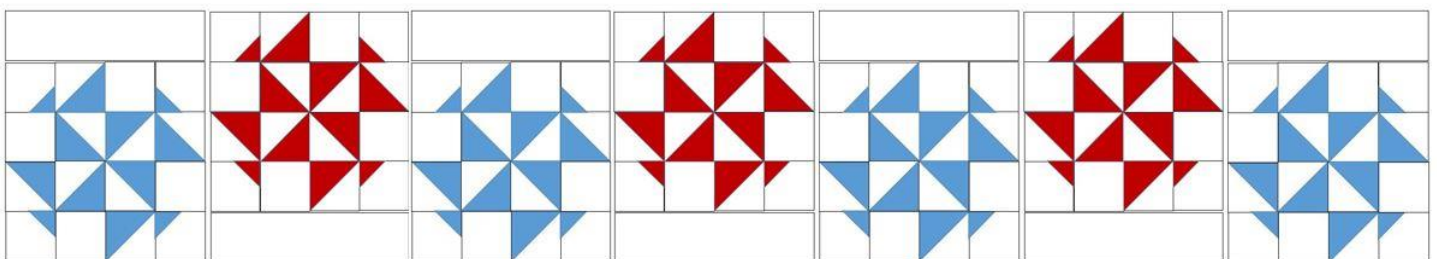
Pin, sew, and press toward the rectangle.
Repeat this process for each of your Snowballs for a total of 7 units.



Step 2: Assembling The Snowballs Row, Part 2

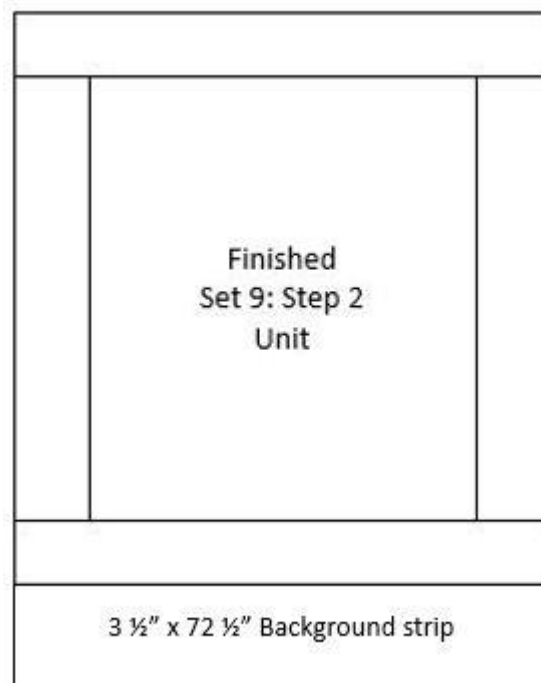
Using the units from Step 1, arrange as shown. Pin, sew, and press.

Note: The blue blocks indicate the M/B SB. The red represent the L/B SB.

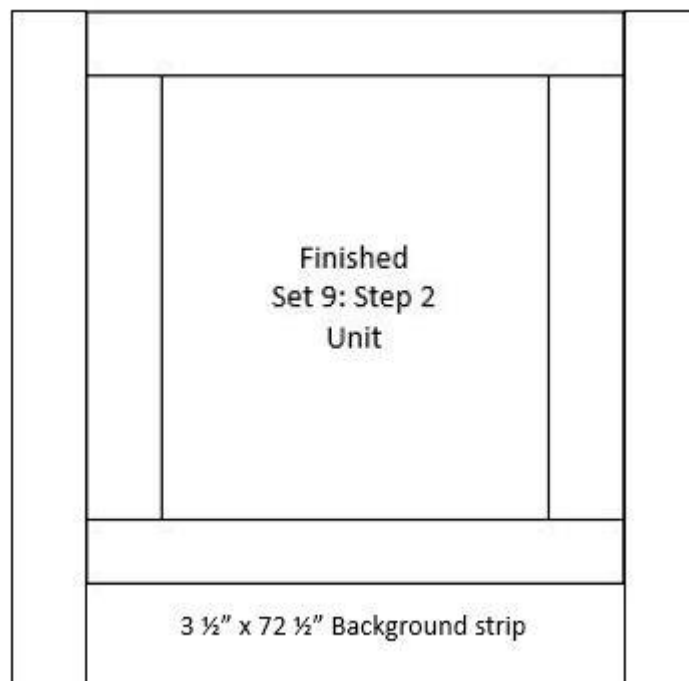


Step 3: Adding the 4th Border Set

A. Using the unit from Set 9: Step 3B and the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $72\frac{1}{2}$ " Background strip you cut in Set 8: Step 5, arrange as shown. Pin, sew, and press.



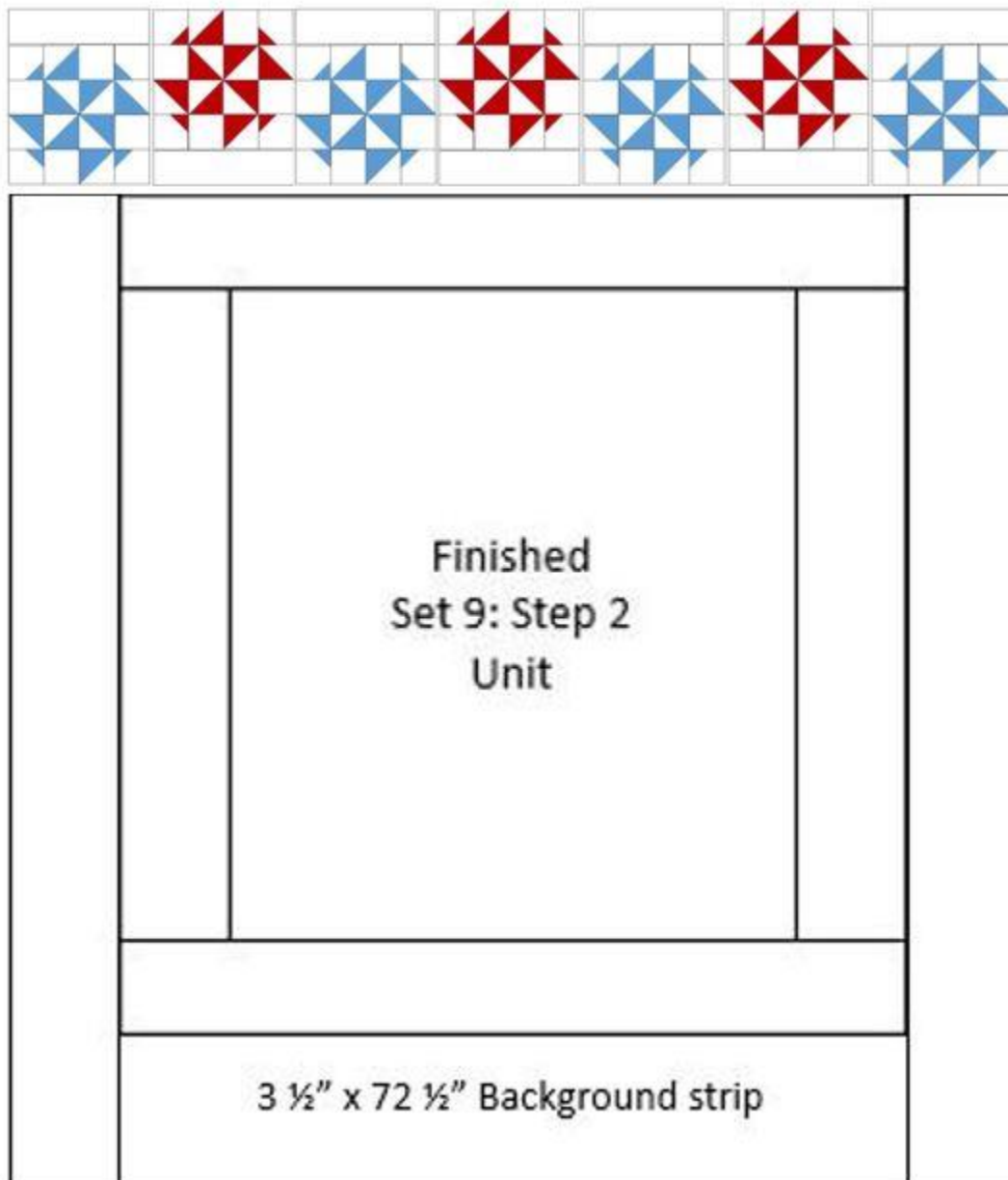
B. Take the (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $81\frac{1}{2}$ " Background strips you cut in Set 8: Step 5, arrange as shown. Pin, sew, and press.



Instruction Set 10 - TWIN

Last Step:

Arrange your Snowballs Row over the top of your Step 3B unit as shown. Pin, sew, press.
