

# Instruction Set 1

## Step 1: Cutting Instructions

Cut each of the following pieces as listed. There are boxes to the left of each item so you can mark them off as you finish cutting.

Flying Geese (FG) and Half-Square Triangles (HST) are marked as indicated for those using different methods than mine.

FG will be  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

HST will be 4" unfinished

\* = HST

\*\* = FG Center (middle part)

\*\*\* = FG Wings (sides)

### Light

- (13)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares\*
- (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square\*\*
- (1) 9" square\*\*\*
- (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (32)  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- (2) 2" x  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- (2) 2" x  $27\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

### Medium

- (4)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares\*
- (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square\*\*
- (1) 9" square\*\*\*
- (20)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

### Dark

- (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square\*
- (1) 9" square\*\*\*
- (32)  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares
- (2) 2" X  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- (2) 2" X  $27\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

### Background

- (10)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares\*
- (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square\*\*
- (132)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- (32)  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

## Step 2: Assembling Flying Geese

Using the Flying Geese tutorial referenced on the main MQ website and the fabric you cut in Step 1, you will need to make units of the following combinations and amounts:

- Background (center) and Light (Wings) = make 4 FG
- Light (center) and Medium (wings) = make 4 FG
- Medium (center) and Dark (wings) = make 4 FG

**The FG should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " when you have finished trimming them.**
