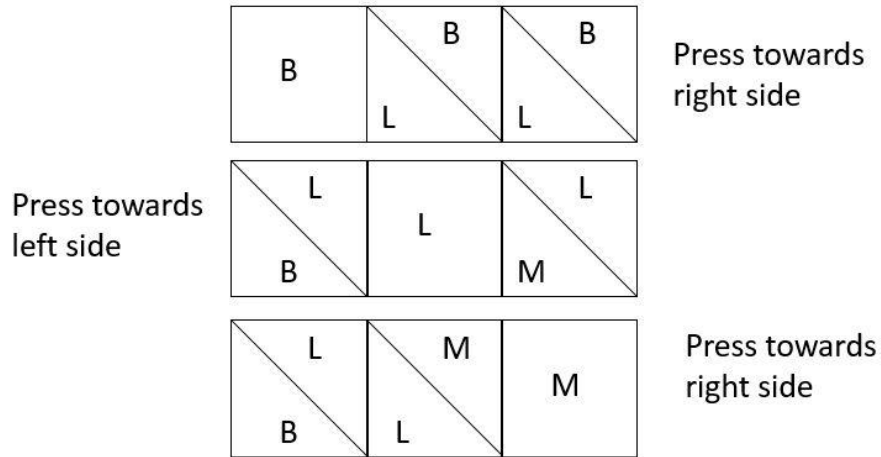


Instruction Set 3

Step 1: Assembling The Center, Part 1

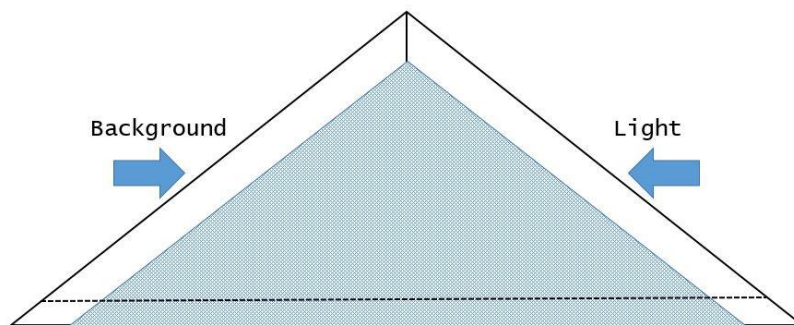
Using the HSTs from Set 2: Step 1 and the solid squares you cut in Set 1: Step 1, arrange the pieces so you have a 3x3 grid like the picture below. Sew your squares and HSTs into rows and press in the direction indicated.



Sew the rows together and press seams towards the top of your block.

Step 2: Assembling QST, Part 2

Using the triangle sets from Set 2: Step 3 and the Dark triangles you cut in Set 2: Step 2, arrange a Dark triangle on top of the Background/Light triangle set RST (right sides together) like this:



The Dark fabric will NOT totally cover the Background/Light set. Do your best to match the top point of the Dark with the seam of your Background/Light Set. Pin along the bottom edge. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam (where the line is drawn on the image).

Repeat for a total of (64) partial Quarter Square Triangles (pQST).

Press your pQST to the Dark fabric.

Step 3: Trimming pQST

Using the tutorial posted by Generations Quilt Patterns, begin with Step 8, “To trim an oversized unit down to size...” and trim your pQST to 3 ½” square.

Step 4: Cutting Instructions (to be used next time)

HST will be 3 ½” unfinished

* = HST

Light

- (28) 4 ½” squares*
- (28) 3 ½” squares

Medium

- (84) 4 ½” squares*

Dark

- (56) 4 ½” squares*

Background

- (56) 4 ½” squares*
- (24) 3 ½” x 6 ½”
- (4) 6 ½” squares

IF you are making a twin and you cut all the 3 ½” squares in Set 1, Step 1, cut only 1
